GOLF MAINTENANCE WORKER

NATURE OF WORK

This work involves the maintenance of golf course grounds.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS (Any one position may not perform all of the duties listed, nor do the listed examples include all of the duties that may be performed in positions allocated to this class. Also, the duties are not necessarily listed in order of importance or frequency of performance.)

Mows grass and trims trees and hedges.

Picks up trash and litter and empties trash receptacles.

Moves tee markers and putting green cups.

Rakes and maintains sand traps.

Performs primary maintenance on equipment, ensuring that oil is at the proper level and that they are filled with fuel.

Performs other duties as assigned or as the situation dictates within the scope of this classification.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES

Ability to understand written and oral instructions.

Ability to push a mower from 75 to 100% of the work day.

Ability to use up to one hundred (100) pounds of force occasionally and up to seventy-five (75) frequently to move objects.

EQUIPMENT OPERATION (Any one position may not use all of the tools and equipment listed nor do the listed examples comprise all of the tools and equipment that may be used in positions allocated to this classification.)
