## **PRESCHOOL PROGRAMMER**

### NATURE OF WORK

This work involves teaching a variety of preschool activities and classes.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS (Any one position may not perform all of the duties listed, nor do the listed examples include all of the duties that may be performed in positions allocated to this class. Also, the duties are not necessarily listed in order of importance or frequency of performance.)

Plans, organizes, and supervises preschool activities and special events.

Teaches preschool classes and state licensed preschool programs.

Compiles the preschool curriculum according to state licensed preschool guidelines.

Orders supplies, provides arts and crafts samples, and maintains budget guidelines.

Plans and supervises the conduct of field trips, holiday programs, and parties.

Drives a vehicle to transport participants on field trips.

Plans and provides nutritious snack menus.

Registers participants and collects money as needed.

Provides customer assistance, and responds to inquiries and complaints.

Cleans the facility and grounds.

Performs other duties as assigned or as the situation dictates within the scope of this classification.

### REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES

Knowledge of the principles of early childhood development.

Knowledge of the rules and play of preschool age games and motor activities.

Ability meet all state licensed preschool requirements.

Ability to assist in planning and supervising activities and special events.

Ability to maintain current accurate records, especially participants' immunization records.

Ability to work effectively with people of all ages and levels of ability.

Ability to communicate effectively with co-workers and the public.

Ability to understand oral and written instructions.

Ability to move about the facility 75 to 100% of the workday.

### SPECIAL QUALIFICATIONS

Must be able to work varied times, including weekends and holidays.

Must possess current First Aid and Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) certificates.

Must possess a valid driver's license.
