## **SKATEGUARD**

### NATURE OF WORK

This work involves monitoring activities on the ice at a skating arena.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS (Any one position may not perform all of the duties listed, nor do the listed examples include all of the duties that may be performed in positions allocated to this class. Also, the duties are not necessarily listed in order of importance or frequency of performance.)

Patrols the skating surface, assisting those in need, administering first aid to injured patrons, and ensuring that all skaters adhere to the rules of the ice.

Receive admission and skate rental fees and hand stamps paying customers.

Distributes rental skates and collects them after each skating session.

Maintain rental skates, sharpening them and replacing laces.

Assists in cleaning the facility.

Installs and removes ice hockey goal nets.

Performs other duties as assigned or as the situation dictates within the scope of this classification.

### REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES

Knowledge of basic first aid techniques.

Skill in skating in all directions and the ability to stop at will.

Ability to use tact in enforcing the rules of the ice.

Ability to communicate effectively with co-workers and the public.

Ability to understand written and oral instructions.

Ability to move about the arena 90 to 100% of the time.

SPECIAL QUALIFICATIONS

Must be at least sixteen (16) years of age.

Must be able to work varied hours and days, including early mornings, evenings, weekends, and holidays.
