

**ELECTION NOTICE
CITY OF OMAHA
EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM BOARD OF TRUSTEES**

TO: ALL MEMBERS OF THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM

The City of Omaha Employees' Retirement System ordinances provide for the election by secret ballot of one member of the System to serve a three-year term as a trustee. Three members of the Board of Trustees are elected by members of the System and the term of one trustee expires each year (Chapter 22-41, Omaha Municipal Code).

The Election Committee of the City of Omaha Employees' Retirement System Board of Trustees announces an election to be held for the purpose of selecting one (1) trustee to serve on the Board for a three-year term, 2015 through 2017. The term of SCOTT MCINTYRE, PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, expires at the end of 2014. This vacancy may be filled by any member from any department except the City Clerk's Office and Finance—representatives from these departments (Buster Brown and Donna Waller) are now members of the Board.

NOMINATIONS:

In place of a general meeting, nominations will be made and filed in the office of the Human Resources Department, Room 506, Omaha/Douglas Civic Center, between **October 6, 2014, and October 17, 2014, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.** Any member of the System may nominate any other eligible member to serve.

Nomination forms can be obtained in the Human Resources Department beginning October 6, 2014. Nomination forms can also be located at <http://www.cityofomaha.org/humanresources/public-documents/retirement-systems/206>. No second to the nomination is required.

VOTING:

The election will be by secret mailed ballot.

Members of the City of Omaha Employees' Retirement System as of **November 1, 2014**, will be mailed a ballot and may vote for one (1) candidate only.

Ballots will be mailed on **November 7, 2014**. Returned ballots must be postmarked no later than **November 28, 2014**, and received in the Human Resources Department, Room 506 Omaha/Douglas Civic Center, no later than **4:30 p.m. on December 1, 2014**.

The Election Committee will supervise the ballot count in the Human Resources Department and will announce the results of the election no later than **December 9, 2014**.
