

ELECTION NOTICE

TO: All Sworn Personnel of the Police and Fire Departments

The Election Committee of the Police and Fire Retirement System Board of Trustees announces an election to be held for the purpose of selecting one (1) trustee to serve on the board for the three-year term 2012-2014. The term of Police Lieutenant George Merithew expires at the end of 2011.

NOMINATIONS:

Three trustees, selected by the membership through secret ballot, serve on the board along with two ex-officio trustees, one City Councilmember, and one non-member trustee selected by the board. No more than two elected trustees can come from one Department. Since each Department has a representative whose seat is not available for election, nominations can be accepted for members of both the Police and Fire Departments.

Nominations will be accepted from **October 3 through October 14, 2011, between 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.** Nomination forms can be obtained in the Human Resources Department beginning October 3, 2011. Nomination forms can also be located at <http://www.cityofomaha.org/humanresources/public-documents/retirement-systems/police-fire-elections>. No second to the nomination is required.

VOTING:

The election will use secret mail ballots.

Members of the Police and Fire Retirement System as of **October 29, 2011**, will be mailed a ballot and may vote for one (1) candidate only.

Ballots will be mailed **November 7, 2011**. Returned ballots must be postmarked no later than **November 25, 2011**, and received in the Human Resources Department, Room 506, Omaha/Douglas Civic Center, no later than **4:30 p.m. on November 28, 2011**.

The Election Committee will supervise the ballot count in the Human Resources Department and will announce the results of the election no later than **12:00 noon on December 6, 2011**.
