

ELECTION NOTICE

TO: All Sworn Personnel of the Police and Fire Departments

The Election Committee of the Police and Fire Retirement System Board of Trustees announces an election to be held for the purpose of selecting one (1) trustee to serve on the board for the three-year term 2014-2016. The term of Fire Captain Michael Henrich expires at the end of 2013.

NOMINATIONS:

Three trustees, selected by the membership through secret ballot, serve on the board along with two ex-officio trustees, one City Councilmember, and one non-member trustee selected by the board. No more than two elected trustees can come from one Department. Since the Police Department has two representatives whose seats are not available for election, nominations can only be accepted for members of the Fire Department.

Nominations will be accepted from **October 7, 2013, through October 18, 2013, between 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.** Nomination forms can be obtained in the Human Resources Department beginning October 7, 2013. Nomination forms can also be located at <http://www.cityofomaha.org/humanresources/public-documents/retirement-systems/police-fire-elections>. No second to the nomination is required.

VOTING:

The election will use secret mail ballots.

Members of the Police and Fire Retirement System as of **November 1, 2013**, will be mailed a ballot and may vote for one (1) candidate only.

Ballots will be mailed **November 12, 2013**. Returned ballots must be postmarked no later than **November 29, 2013**, and received in the Human Resources Department, Room 506, Omaha/Douglas Civic Center, no later than **4:30 p.m. on December 2, 2013**.

The Election Committee will supervise the ballot count in the Human Resources Department and will announce the results of the election no later than **December 10, 2013**.
